

CLUB PERSON AWARD



All sporting clubs rely on the contribution of volunteers to succeed. Essendon Netball Club's Club Person Award, seeks to acknowledge the significant contribution one individual has made towards the smooth operation and success of the Club in the previous year. This person's contribution is consistent, voluntary and reflective of the Club's ethos. Essendon's Club Person works tirelessly for the betterment of the Club, without the expectation of recognition. They represent an excellent role model for all members. The Club Person does not have to occupy a club position or have any specific job.

The Club Person Award is announced at our Presentation Night.

Selection Criteria

Significant off-court contributions made to the running and success of the Club over the previous 12 months (eg. assisting with functions, club and/or team management, game day logistics and using their skills for the benefit of the Club)

Person who has shown an ongoing commitment to the Essendon Netball Club

Nominees who have held paid positions within the club (eg. coaching or umpiring) must demonstrate that their commitment to the club extends outside their paid duties

Must have been a full member for at least 12 months

Nomination

A written submission made by any full member

Members are prevented from nominating anyone within their family, inclusive of children, siblings or partners etc

The nominating party may be invited to a committee meeting to advocate on behalf of their nominee

To be voted by the committee with a single vote given to each member

If single voting results in a tie, all committee members will re-vote using the 3,2,1 system

Nominations are to be forwarded to the Secretary.
