<b>Title</b>	Head Coach
<b>Position Summary</b>	<p>To promote the enjoyment of, and participation in netball, of both players and coaches</p> <p>Develop player's and coaches' understanding and knowledge of the game of netball, as well the skills necessary to participate effectively and safely</p>
<b>Key duties and responsibilities</b>	<p>Oversee and manage all players and coaches participating in EDNA netball competitions</p> <p>Support and assist coaches with their training and game day plans, as well as provide opportunities for skill development eg participation in, and attendance at, coaching courses</p> <p>Promote and encourage professional accreditation of all coaches</p> <p>Provide encouragement and a positive mentorship and environment, for new and emerging coaches</p> <p>Conduct monthly meetings with all coaches</p> <p>Provide constructive and positive feedback to coaches in order that they feel empowered and motivated to improve their coaching abilities</p> <p>Provide all coaches with a Game Day Booklet</p> <p>Liaise with, and report to, the Committee on all coaching related issues</p> <p>Work closely with the Junior Registration Co-ordinator to determine team composition and registration at the beginning of each season</p> <p>Demonstrate an understanding of the By-Laws and rules governing the EDNA competition</p> <p>Through example, foster a love/enjoyment of the game of netball in the Club's players, and demonstrate what good sportsmanship is about</p> <p>Liaise with Equipment Co-ordinator to ensure all equipment requirements are met</p> <p>Promote ENC via programs such as NetSetGo, and further develop players' skills via participation in tournaments</p> <p>Attend the Annual General Meeting (AGM)</p> <p>Manage <a href="mailto:headcoach@essendonnetballclub.com.au">headcoach@essendonnetballclub.com.au</a></p>
